

Waiver for Serious Food Allergies or other Medical Conditions

The parents of a child with serious food allergies, or other serious medical concerns, must take complete responsibility for the health and welfare of their child. For this child to attend classes held by the Encourager's Co-op, this waiver must be signed by a parent/legal guardian at the time of registration, or at any time during the semester that a serious condition is determined, acknowledging that their child's health issues are their responsibility, and not that of the Encourager's Co-op, its Board of Directors, or its class leaders/facilitators.

WAIVER:

I have indicated on the medical portion of the registration form for Encourager's Co-op, that my child has a serious allergy or medical condition. I acknowledge that the health and welfare of my child is my responsibility. The Encourager's Co-op, its Board of Directors, and class leaders/facilitators are not responsible for any adverse reactions or medical emergencies that may occur while attending classes.
